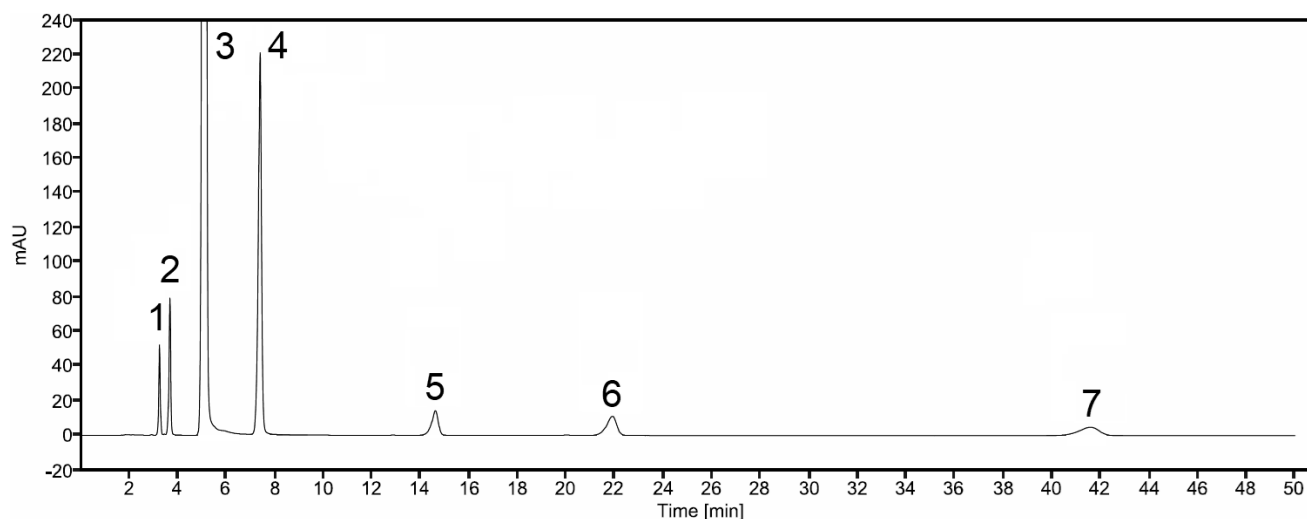




Aspirin Dispersible Tablets – BP 2025
