PARACETAMOL ORAL SOLUTION BP 2025

RELATED SUBSTANCES

It has come to our attention that a wash step in the related substances gradient table of the monograph for Paracetamol Oral Solution in the BP 2025 was omitted in error. This wash step is necessary for the elution of late retaining excipients in oral solution products.

The gradient table will be amended as follows, the changed text has been highlighted:

Time (Minutes)	Mobile phase A (% v/v)	Mobile phase B (% v/v)	Comment
0-1.5	95	5	isocratic
1.5-14.5	95→90	5→10	linear gradient
14.5-29	90	10	isocratic
29-58	90→66	10→34	linear gradient

65-80	20	80	isocratic
80-81	20→95	80→5	linear gradient
81-90	95	5	re-equilibration

The revised monograph will be published in a future edition of the British Pharmacopoeia - the current target publication is the BP 2027, which will come into force on 1st January 2027.
