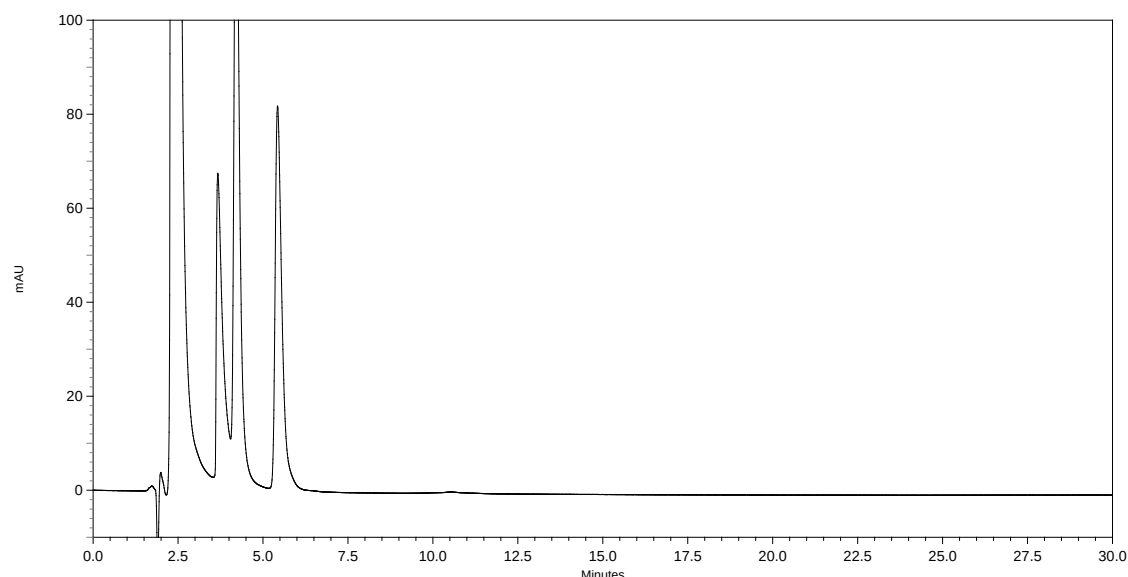




Tobramycin injection – BP 2016

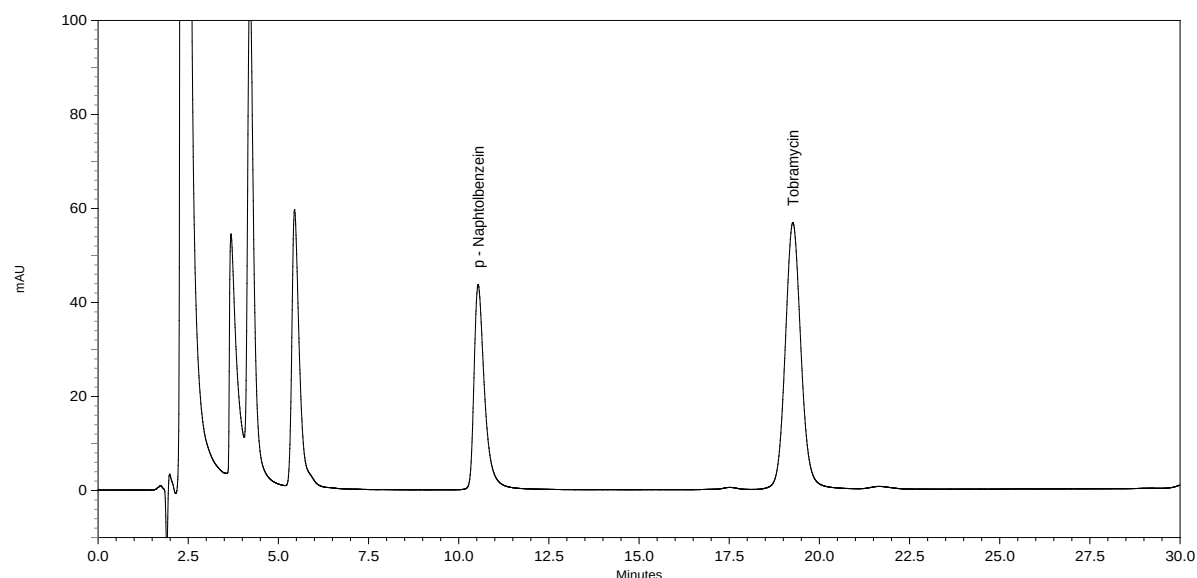
These chromatograms are provided for information only as an aid to analysts and intended as guidance for the interpretation and application of BP monographs.

Typical chromatogram for solution (4) in the Assay test for Tobramycin Injection as published in BP 2016.



The chromatogram shows four blank peaks, at 2.5 minutes ((off scale at 100 mAU), 3.7 minutes (70 mAU), 4.5 minutes (off scale at 10 mAU) and 5.5 minutes (80 mAU).

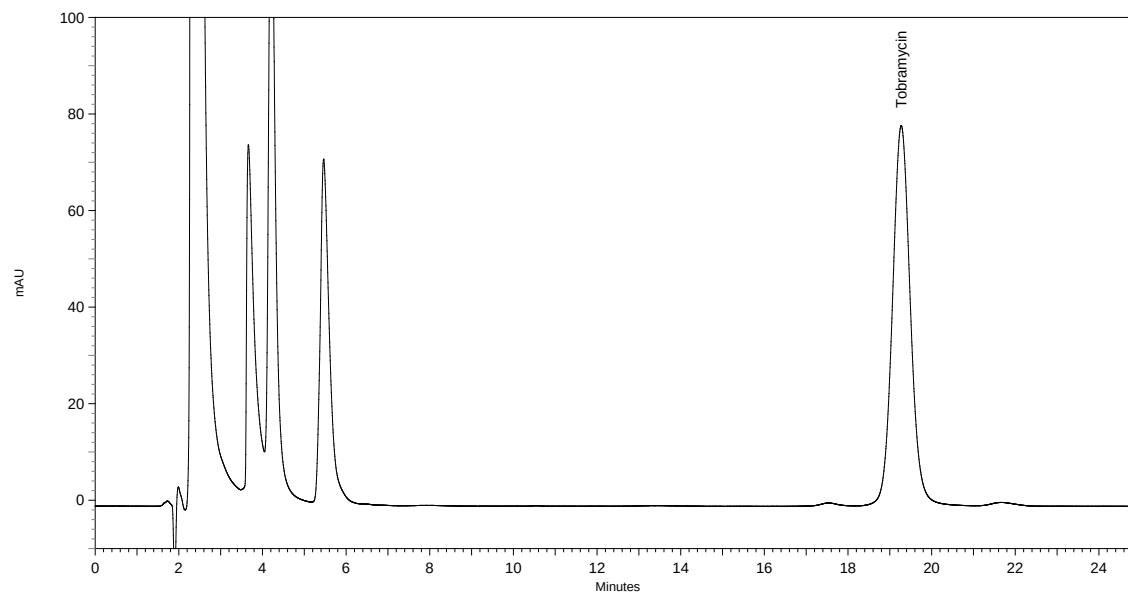
Typical chromatogram for solution (3) in the Assay test for Tobramycin Injection as published in BP 2016.



The chromatogram shows two peaks, p-Naphtolbenzein (45 mAU) at 10.5 minutes and tobramycin (60 mAU) at 19.3 minutes.



Typical chromatogram for solution (2) in the Assay test for Tobramycin Injection as published in BP 2016.



The chromatogram shows a large tobramycin peak (80 mAU) at 19.3 minutes.
